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Pursuant to Sec. 2.60.040 (f) of the Judiciary Ordinance of the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians, Rule 12 (d)(2) of the General Rules of Court is amended as follows:

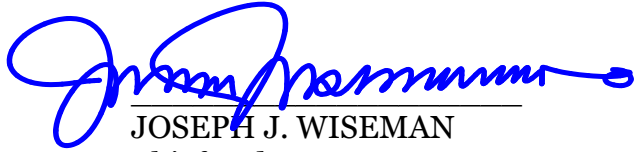
(d) *Methods of Service.*

- (1) Any person who is at least 18 years old and not a party may serve a document. At the plaintiff's request, the Court may order that service be made by a local law enforcement officer or by a person specially appointed by the Court.
- (2) A document is served by:
 - (A) Handing it to the person;
 - (B) Leaving it:
 - (i) At the person's office with a clerk or other person in charge or, if no one is in charge, in a conspicuous place in the office; or
 - (ii) If the person has no office or the office is closed, at the person's dwelling or usual place of abode with someone of suitable age and discretion who resides there;
 - (C) Mailing it to the person's last known address—in which event service is complete upon mailing;
 - (D) Provided that the person has consented to in writing, filing it with the Court's electronic-filing system or sending it by other electronic means—in either of which events service is complete upon filing or sending;

- (E) Delivering it by any other means that the person consented to in writing—in which event service is complete when the person making service delivers it to the agency designated to make delivery;
- (F) Publishing it in a newspaper of general circulation, if authorized by the Court; or
- (G) Delivering it by any alternative method of service authorized by the Court.
