

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

PSL-47/47A SUBLEASE CELL TOWER PROJECT FONSI

Notice is hereby given that the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), Pacific Regional Office, has made a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI), dated May 19, 2021, for the approval of a Sublease (pursuant to master lease PSL-47/47A) between the Agua Caliente Development Authority (Lessor or Tribe) and AT&T Mobility, LLC (Lessee). The purpose of the sublease is for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a cell tower and related facilities within a golf course owned and operated by the Tribe (Proposed Action).

Based on the analysis and impacts in a previously released Environmental Assessment (EA), and the entire administrative record, the BIA is issuing a FONSI. This finding ends the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) environmental review process.
